- 2. Citizen/Public Comments.

Rose- wants chairman to tell group how to vote and read it back for the record.

Charles- please vote by chat and staff/chair can read back vote

3. Council Liaison Report.

Rudi- lift station update, permit software update, upper cougar creek development discussion, special taxes on ballot, Terracon hired for pond, Google fiber no longer working in the city, emergency order for severe weather, approved MyPermitNow and amended fees to help pay for it, approved Oct & Nov Financial Statements, approved SUP for alcohol at Mighty Fine, approved Doc's to manage playground, joint meeting between committee chairs and council on March 2.

Sylvia- FEMA for severe weather, MyPermitNow info

4. Approve the meeting minutes from the January 28, 2021 meeting.

5. Presentation on Monthly Sales Tax Revenue and Funds

Charles Y- would like to strictly adhere to Open Meetings Act, suggested times on agenda to keep to 2 hour meeting

Rose- how to ask for future agenda items. Sylvia responded public comments Chip responded item "Suggestions for Future Agenda Items"

Rose- why committee login for opengov? Sylvia responded that it is for working documents. Charles Y- likes to dig into reports, is that still available? Sylvia responded you can dig into portal if you like. Ariel thinks digging down into data is very important and doesn't want it to see it. Rose agrees and wants more information when drilled down (check numbers, invoice, etc). Sylvia drilled down to show where information can be found. Charles Y-should this be a future agenda item? Rose said she is fine with the answers she received. Ariel said she would like to discuss the actual financials more than OpenGov. Charles Y agreed.

Charles Y- went over taxes and showed a table with the last 2 years' sales tax revenues by category for reference. Justin- is there somewhere committee can see fund balances? Sylvia- not in OpenGov, have Suzanna create a table, balance sheet.

Rose- wants to know what HOT is owed, owed utilities, ETJ fire payment owed. Sylvia- it is in drill down. HOT is self reported, hard to determine exact amount. Utilities owed at \$50,000, down from \$80,000; establishing a repayment plan

Ketan- is Mixed Beverage part of GF? Sylvia: yes. Ketan- Fire payment is in OpenGov as fire collection fees Charles Y- would like to give a packet of info to new committee members on Sales Taxes

Michael- would like to see fund balances as part of monthly presentations

Charles G- would like restricted items broken out in fund balances

Charles Y- Sales taxes look good, only down 1% for the month, 4% for the year compared to last year. Michaelwould like to lock down revenue numbers better for next year.

Ketan- would like information to be published once, not live if it's not ready to be viewed.

Charles G- CARES money- how dependent are we on it? Sylvia- we have already received \$32,000 from Travis County and is not continuous or ongoing

Ariel- increased janitorial costs- connected with building move? Sylvia- no, contract cost was increased despite going out for bid on a new vendor

Ketan- emergency fund not budgeted? Sylvia- used in emergency situation for tracking

Ketan- contract services expenses- grounds maintenance is it more than anticipated or unusual? Sylvia-contract is more but has more flexibility

Ketan- proposed new line? Sylvia- project- portion of sunset trail. May or may not occur

Charles Y- some items will be over budget if we keep going at this pace. Sylvia- some will have adjusting entries, legal fees looks like it will exceed budget if not reigned in
