## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNSET VALLEY TEXAS, RATIFYING THE ADOPTION OF THE 2023 PARKS AND OPEN SPACE PLAN

**WHEREAS**, the City Council approved an Agreement for Professional Services with Asakura Robinson for the preparation of the Parks and Open Space Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, Sunset Valley Residents and visitors were engaged through on-line surveys, community workshops, and popup events; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parks and Open Space Ad hoc Committee received the public comments and conducted extensive review of the proposed plan; and,

**WHEREAS** a final draft of the plan was presented to City Council on November 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Parks and Open Space Plan will cover all aspects of parks, recreation, trails and open space and will serve as a guideline for prioritizing projects and fiscal planning of quality of life enhancements in the City of Sunset Valley for the next ten years; and,

**WHEREAS**, after the subject public hearings, studies, and reviews, the City Council has considered the final report and has accepted the recommended changes incorporated the 2023 Parks and Open Space Plan to be adopted in accordance with the limitations, restrictions, and requirements of Chapter 213 of the Texas Local Government Code; and,

**WHEREAS**, each property will be evaluated through the design process prior to construction and approved by City Council following public input to further refine the City's needs and desire; and,

**WHEREAS**, the use of this plan is of an advisory nature and construction of any parts of the plan will be governed by the needs of the City, available funding, and subject to final approval by the City Council.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNSET VALLEY, TEXAS, THAT;

**Section 1.** The facts and recitations set forth in the preamble of this resolution are hereby found to be true and correct.

**Section 2.** The 2023 Parks and Open Space Plan is hereby adopted pursuant to the limitations, restrictions and requirements of Section 213 of the Texas Local Government Code, as contained herein.

**Section 3.** Severability. If any clause or provision of this resolution shall be deemed to be unenforceable for any reason, such unenforceable clause or provision shall be severed from the remaining portion of the resolution, which shall continue to have full force and effect.

**Section 4.** Repeal. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are expressly repealed.

**Section 5.** Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective upon passage by the City Council.
