SALES TAX SNAPSHOT Sunset Valley







Sales Tax Collections by Industry Segment











(Prior Fiscal Year + Current Fiscal Year-to-Date)






SALES TAX TREND Sunset Valley - Comp Jun-21

SUBJECT: GRANT PROGRAM

DESCRIPTION: Consider and award the Sunset Valley Stimulus Program Small Business Grants

BACKGROUND: On May 18th City Council approved the Sunset Valley Stimulus Program for an amount of \$120,000, and after revisions from the City Attorney and a final review from the CED Committee on June 2nd, the program was implemented. A business may be awarded up to \$10,000. If there are over 12 qualified applicants for the program, the program funds will be distributed evenly among the qualified applicants.

In order to be considered for the grant, a business must meet the following criteria:

- Physical and publicly accessible location within the City of Sunset Valley city limits (no home-based businesses).
- Experienced or projected to experience a decline in revenue and/or employment beginning on March 1, 2020 through June 1, 2021.
- In good standing with the City of Sunset Valley regarding licensing and finance (e.g., being current on sales and use tax payments, utility, etc.).
- Must be registered with the Texas Comptroller's Office as a sales tax revenue generating business for the City of Sunset Valley.
- Have less than five million dollars (\$5,000,000) in annual gross revenues.
- Engaged in activities that are legal under city and state law.

Ineligible businesses include national chains and home-based businesses.

As of July 1, 2021, seven (7) Sunset Valley Businesses have applied:

- Stouthaus Coffee
- Party City
- Brodie Nails
- Bao'd Up
- Bougies Donuts
- Cruzteca
- Crumbl Cookie

The Grant Applications will be emailed to Committee Members, and any additional applications received before the deadline (5:00 P.M. on July 7th) will also be distributed to the Committee.
